The rightful owner of any design is the company or artist who was hired by the client to design the work. Many artists help one another on large jobs as well as provide budding artists with opportunities to learn. The proper steps to follow if you would like to include those decor images in your idea book are to ask the creator's permission. Similarly, helping on large scale projects while at a convention can provide wonderful photos for your idea book as long as permission and proper credit are used.
